Changes at Castlepoint Shopping Park Legacies help others in the future

Re-construction of the car park continues into the second phase of a 5 year building programme . If you've visited Shopmobility recently (also the main SEDCAT working office), you may have noticed signs for a Red car park and a Blue car park. You can't drive between the red and the blue areas so you need to access Shopmobility from the ground floor of the **Blue** Car Park which is nearest to B&Q. We are still in Aisle 11 next to the new car wash. Take care coming in and out as there is a temporary exit through the Shopmobility car park and this will be especially busy towards Xmas.

All shops are open as normal throughout and can be accessed by foot or scooter from either car park. Castlepoint Shopmobility will eventually be moving to a new location, still on the ground floor but within the area of the **Red** car park. The move will happen towards the end of 2020 and more details will be released to members and on the website nearer the time. Services are likely to be interrupted during the move so we will keep you updated.



One of the ways of securing the future of these services is through a legacy. This is a gift left to a charity in a Will. This type of donation means that a donor is not putting themselves in any precarious financial position *and* can still access savings to pay for whatever needs they may have, BUT, the donor is still able to give something back to the charity that helps them.

This could be life changing for others... How can a legacy be left?

A donation can be either general or specific, for example towards a new bus or a mobility scooter or to help towards running costs

If someone already has a will and then wishes to include a gift to **sedcat** in it, there may not be any need to rewrite it. A qualified professional such as a solicitor can add an amendment (called a codicil) to a Will. As a general rule, if the change is quite small or simple, a codicil can be used, and if the change is more significant or complex a new Will should be made.

We do not need to be told, as it is something very private and personal, but it might be useful



if this is at all possible. Charitable donations are exempt from tax which means that 100% of a donation will go to SEDCAT
